Kansas Water Vision Summary

A summary of testimony provided on January 14, 2015, by Tracy Streeter, Kansas Water Office and Jackie McClaskey, Department of Agriculture, was distributed to the Committee (Attachment 1).

Update on Local Food and Farm Task Force

Joanna Wochner, Legislative Research Department, presented an update on <u>SB 286</u>, passed during the 2014 Legislative Session, which established the Local Food and Farm Task Force (<u>Attachment 2</u>). The Task Force is responsible for preparing a local food and farm plan containing policy and funding recommendations in order to increase locally grown food production. The Task Force is composed of seven members: three members appointed by the Governor; one member representing the Department of Agriculture; one member representing the KSU Extension Systems and Research programs; and one member each from the House Agriculture and Research and Senate Agriculture Committees. Ms. Wochner noted that Representative Lusker, a member of this committee, has been appointed to the Task Force.

Ms. Wochner stated that the Task Force has met twice to discuss strategic and funding needs; recommendations for future expansion of locally-grown produce to be sold in grocery stores and farmer's markets. The next meeting of the Task Force is scheduled for January 23, 2015.

Representative Lusker made a few comments, noting that the Task Force is working to find ways to bring locally grown produce to rural areas, low-income citizens and improve the economy for local producers.

Ms. Wochner and Representative Lusker responded to questions from the Committee.
