Bill introductions

Greg Foley, Department of Agriculture, appeared before the Committee to request the introduction of two pieces of legislation regarding (1) RS#0899 regarding agriculture liming material act and (2) RS#0797 regarding administrative hearings.

Representative Sloan moved to introduce the two pieces of legislation as requested by the Department of Agriculture. Motion was seconded by Representative Schroeder. Motion was adopted without objection.

<u>Discussion & possible action on: HB2030 — Amendments to the Kansas pet animal act.</u> Chair Schwartz opened the discussion and possible action on <u>HB 2030</u>.

Representative Sloan moved to recommend **HB 2030** favorable for passage. Motion was seconded by Representative Victors.

Responding to a question from the Committee, Dr. Bill Brown, Kansas Livestock Commissioner, Department of Agriculture, indicated that a breeder can hold a state license and also a federal license, depending on whether they ship in-state or out-of-state. Mr. Brown noted that those holding USDA license will be inspected by the federal government as well as inspection by the state. Additional information on **HB 2030** from Dr. Brown was distributed to the Committee (Attachment 1).

Representative Lusker moved to amend **HB 2030** by reinserting striken language on page 3 and page 13 "collecting, accumulating, amassing or" (Attachment 2). The motion was seconded by
