Presentation on: National Bio and Agro-Defense Facility (NBAF), KSU

Dr. Ron Trewyn, Assistant to the President and National Bio and Agro-Defense Facility (NBAF) Liaison, Kansas State University (KSU), gave a presentation (Attachment 1) on NBAF at KSU, Manhattan.

The \$1.25 billion lab's mission will be to protect U.S. livestock from foreign animal diseases (FADs) including Zoonotic (animals to/from people) threats. The purpose will be to safeguard food animal health and public health, preserving America's food supply and agricultural economy.

The lab construction will be completed by December 2020, and the transition from Plum Island will be August 2023.

The facility will involve government, industry, and the university. Two office park buildings will be available for leasing to businesses working closely with NBAF.

Dr. Trewyn stood for questions. Representative Kleeb asked about the return on investment to the state for the money invested. Dr. Trewyn indicated global companies have been contacting him. The facility is also attracting local companies. Over 400 people will be employed. In May, a summit is scheduled on NBAF to attract businesses. The first summit was held in June 2015.
