**Discussion & possible action on: SB352 - Amending nonresident real estate broker and salesperson license requirements.**

The Chair asked the Committee's desire on this bill. Chuck Reimer, Revisor, gave an overview. This bill would amend the real estate licensure law to allow non-resident and real estate brokers to apply for a Kansas real estate salesperson's license. The current law only allows non-resident real estate brokers to apply for a Kansas real estate broker's license.

*Representative Mason moved, seconded by Representative Williams, the bill be passed. The motion carried.*

**Discussion & possible action on: HB2718 — Beer sales by grocery stores and convenience stores if cereal malt beverage is no longer available.**

Chuck Reimer gave an overview of this bill. This bill deals with cereal malt beverages (CMB) and what happens to beer and cereal malt beverage sales if CMB manufacturing declines.

*Representative Claeys moved, seconded by Representative Davis, the bill be passed.*

*Representative Corbet moved a substitute motion, seconded by Representative Ruiz, to table the bill. The motion carried.*
