- 4) Does requiring a property owner's consent for inspection protect a tenant's privacy rights? In the city I live in, the tenant's consent is required, not the property owner's.
- 5) I live in a city that has had a rental registration/inspection ordinance for over a decade. What has happened that make it necessary to present this legislation now?
- 6) Is an administrative search warrant considered a "search warrant" as the legislation is written?
