Chairman Hutton, Vice Chair and Members of the Committee,

I am Philip Bradley representing the Kansas Licensed Beverage Association. Thank you for your time.

We take no position on the HB 2718 overall, however as we read it, this bill omits those CMB licensees that serve on premise. We believe this is simply an oversight, and can be fixed. If not addressed it would leave these KS businesses without the same services as the off premise licensees.

If you decide to advance HB 2718 we ask you to amend to make sure you allow the same opportunities to On-Premise CMB license holders. Further we ask that any establishment that is allowed to serve alcoholic beverages adhere to all the restrictions, regulations and requirements as current on premise licensees.

We believe that these amendments to be only fair and they are positive for the state.
