2 new certificates = 5

Redesign work mandated by State Board:

- Performance based systems of licensure and preparation – followed implementation of QPA
- What a teacher should know AND be able to do
- Program standards = knowledge and performance indicators
- Decade of work regs adopted 2000; in effect 2003

- Tiered system of licensure = initial, professional, accomplished (for NBCTs)
- Performance assessment to move to professional
- Fingerprinting
- Content testing/No Child Left Behind highly qualified
- Alternative Preparation programs/licensure = Restricted license
- State board mandate for removing barriers
 - 2 sets of regulations 2007 and 2008
 - New licenses created (Transitional, Interim Alternative, Restricted School Specialist)
 - Adjustments for increased flexibility (exp: adding endorsements by testing)

9 license categories

- Continued review and implementation of regulations for flexibility. Examples:
 - Enhanced options for out-of-state licensed teachers
 - Direct entry option for school counselor, SPED
 - New Career and Technical Education credentials
 - STEM license
- Change in fingerprint requirement
