## Hearing on: HB2131 — Abandoned oil and gas well fund.

Chairman Hedke opened the hearing on **HB2131**.

Matt Sterling, Assistant Revisor of Statutes presented a Bill Brief. (Attachment 1) Following this, he stood for questions.
