<u>Chairman Brunk made a motion to pass **HB2383** our favorably for passage, seconded by Representative James Todd.</u>

<u>Chairman Brunk made another motion to bring the updated bingo rules into **HB2383** to make a New Charitable Bingo and Raffle Act, seconded by Representative Couture-Lovelady.</u>

Jason Long, Revisor of Statutes provided a Balloon Amendment showing the changes made to **HB2383** by combining into it the language from **HB2291** and stood for questions from the Committee. (Attachment 1)

Representative James Todd made a second motion to eliminate the 1% enforcement tax regardless of the amount of receipts, the motion carried.

Representative John Wilson made a substitute motion to reconsider the 1% enforcement tax, seconded by Representative Annie Tietze, the motion failed.

Representative James Todd made a third motion to eliminate the felony requirement on page 3 of the Balloon amendment.
