Approval of Minutes

Chairman Brunk called the meeting to order and asked the Committee for approval of the minutes for March 3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20. Representative Houser made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Representative Lusk, the motioned carried.

Possible final action on bills previously heard

Chairman Brunk called upon the Committee to work **SB 175**. Jason Long, Revisor of Statutes gave a briefing on the bill.

Representative Jones made a motion to pass **SB 175** out favorably for passage, seconded by Representative Scapa. Discussion ensued among the members of the Committee both for and against the bill.

Representative Clayton made a substitute motion to table the bill, seconded by Representative Tietze. Chairman Brunk called for the vote and the outcome was unclear. Division was called and 8 favored the motion and 12 opposed. The motion failed.

Discussion again ensued amongst the Committee members.

After a lengthy discussion Chairman Brunk reminded the Committee that we were back on the original motion to pass the bill out favorably and called for the vote.

Again the outcome of the vote was unclear and division was called. By a show of hands the vote was 12 yeas and 10 nays. The motion carried.
