<u>Vice Chairman Todd made a motion to move out favorably **HB2380** for passage, seconded by <u>Representative Bud Estes.</u></u>

<u>Vice Chairman Todd amended **HB2380** to give leave to Senior Assistant Revisor of Statutes, Jason</u> <u>Long, to bring all the dates of the bill into compliance of the current calendar year, seconded by Pete</u> <u>DeGraaf, motion passed on a voice vote</u>.

There was no discussion.

<u>Representative Don Hineman amended **HB2380** with a balloon amendment, (Attachment 1) seconded by Vice Chairman James Todd, discussion followed: Representatives Pete DeGraaf, Nancy Lusk, John Bradford, John Ewy, Ranking Minority Member Annie Tietze and Chairman Pauls. Vote by show of hands resulted in 12 in favor and 10 opposed. The balloon amendment passed.</u>

<u>Vice Chairman James Todd moved the committee pass out favorably **HB2380** as amended, <u>Representative Susan Concannon seconded, motion passed on a voice vote.</u></u>

# <u>Discussion & possible action on: HB2612 — Refugee resettlement; refugee absorptive capacity act.</u>

Chairman Pauls proceeded with opening the discussion and possible action on <u>HB 2612</u> and recognized Representative Joseph Scapa.

<u>Representative Scapa made a motion to move out favorably HB2612 for passage, Representative John Bradford seconded.</u>

Questions were directed to Senior Assistant Revisor of Statutes, Jason Long, by Substitute Representative Louis Ruiz, Representatives Kristey Williams, John Bradford, Joseph Scapa, and Steven Becker.

Additional discussion was held by Representatives Kristey Williams, Don Hineman, Ben Scott, Dick Jones, Chuck Weber, Brett Hildabrand, Stephanie Clayton, Bud Estes, Susan Concannon, Ranking Minority Member Annie Tietze and Chairman Pauls. <u>Representative Scapa closed on his motion to pass out favorably **HB2612** and a hand count of 12 in favor and 10 opposed was taken, motion carried.</u>
