Possible bill introductions

Representative Mario Goico requested the committee introduce a bill to study gestational diabetes.

Representative Schwab moved to introduce the bill. Representative Wilson seconded and the motion passed.

John Peterson introduced bill sponsored by the Kansas Chiropractic Association to amend sports brain injury bill.

Representative Bollier moved to introduce the bill. Representative Kelly seconded and motion passed.

Representative Hill pre-filed HB2004. He requests bill introduction for drug quality and security act that puts Kansas statute in line for several areas. This bill would reconcile the federal law and state board of pharmacy.

Representative Hill moved that the bill be introduced into committee and Representative Osterman seconded. Motion passed.
