Discussion & possible action on: <u>HB2315 -- Secretary for aging and disability services licensure of</u> certain facilities and standards for treatment of certain individuals.

Norm Furse, staff revisor, distributed a summary of <u>HB2315</u> statutes that would be modified if this bill were passed. Chairman Hawkins appointed a subcommittee to study the changes. <u>Representative Ward proposed an amendment that sponsoring families undergo a background check</u> through DCF. Seconded by Representative Bollier. Discussion ensued. <u>Amendment passed.</u>
