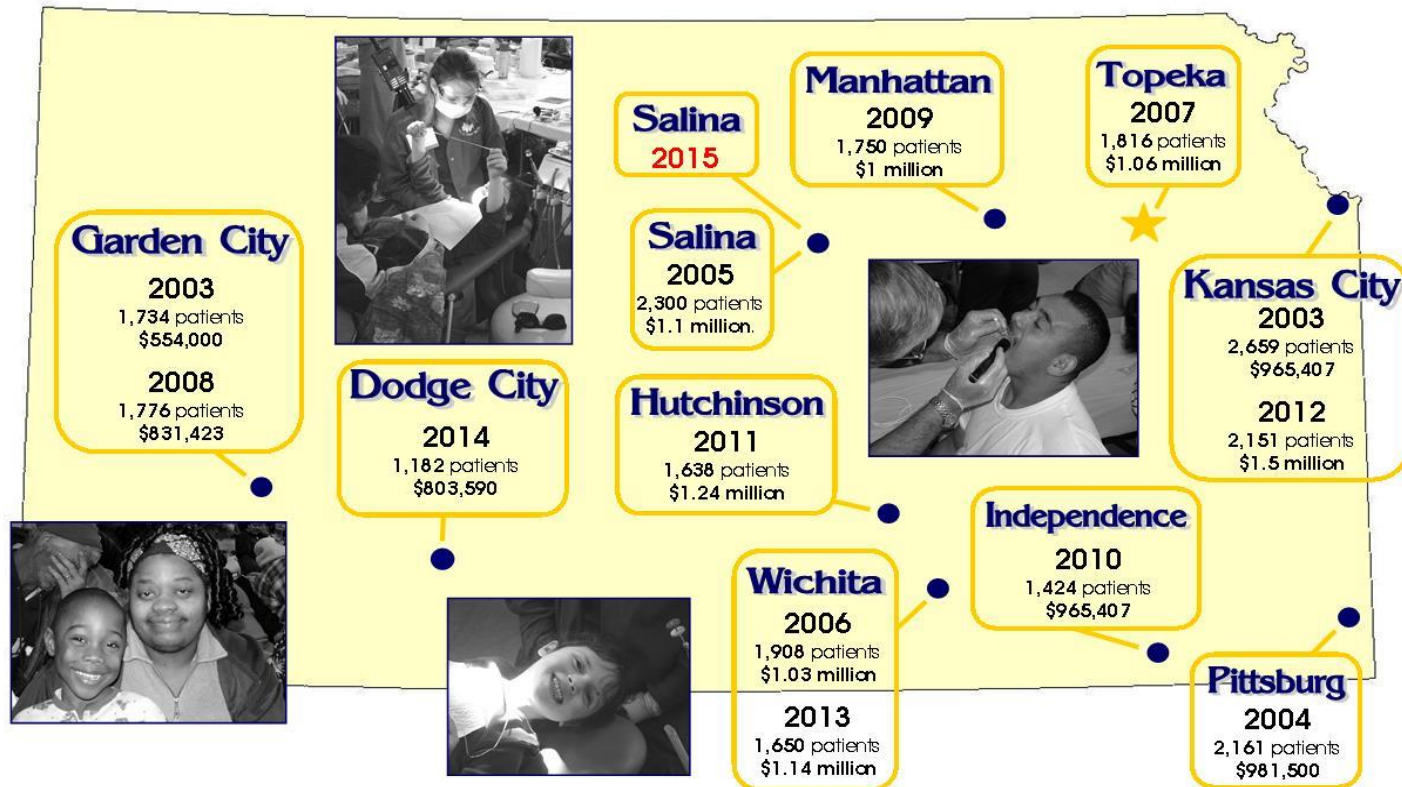

KMOM by the Numbers

- **13 EVENTS** in 10 different Kansas communities
- **24,000+ PATIENTS** treated
- **\$13 MILLION** in free dental services
- **7,600 Total Volunteers**
- **About 50% (726/1,518) of all Kansas DENTISTS** have volunteered at a KMOM event

Making a Difference

- Charitable Healthcare Provider Act
 - KSA 75-6102(e)(4) applies to dentists/dental hygienists
- 1,800-2,000 Patients Treated
- 1,000 Volunteers-150 dentists/150 dental hygienists
 - 85 Clinical Chairs
 - 24 Oral Surgery/Extractions
 - 32 Operative/Fillings
 - 3 Endo/Root Canals
 - 2 Prosthetic/Dentures
 - 8 Children's Clinic
 - 24 Dental Hygiene/Cleaning

- Dental Services Provided to Patients
 - Extractions
 - Restorative/Fillings
 - Dental Hygiene/Cleanings
 - Limited Endo/Root Canals
 - Limited Prosthetic/Dentures/Flippers
 - Pharmacy

Making a Difference

- General Services Provided to Patients
 - Overnight Facilities and Amenities
 - Health Fair/KanCare Information
 - Children's Area, Clowns and Entertainment
 - Breakfast and Lunch
 - Health Screen
 - Dental Care Education
 - Pharmacy
 - Post Op Area/Exit Survey/Gift Bags
 - Post Op/Emergency Treatment for 14 Days

Making a Difference

- Organizing a KMOM includes...
 - Fundraising (\$120,000+) **100% funded by PRIVATE, NON-GOVERNMENT, contributions and grants.**
 - Find a Facility and Clinic Design
 - Public Relations
 - Order Supplies
 - Transportation of Equipment
 - Patient Flow, Crowd Control, Parking & Security
 - Volunteer Recruitment, Food for patients and volunteers

Kansas Mission of Mercy

Making a Difference

- KMOM Survey Results
 - 88% VERY happy with services they received
 - 85% traveled less than 2 hours to clinic
 - 84.5% were over 18 years of age
 - 78.9% did not have dental insurance
 - 68.2% were non-Hispanic white
 - 56.3% reported having pain prior to KMOM
 - 56% had not visited a dentist in the prior two years
