<u>Final Action on SB101-Amending the definition of "health care provider" in the health care provider insurance availability act to exclude certain persons.</u>

David Wiese explained the bill and the Chair called for final action.

Representative Bruchman moved, seconded by Representative Hill, to amend **SB101** by including the contents of **SB117**. Motion carried. Representative Bruchman moved, seconded by Representative Doll, to pass out **SB101** favorably as amended. Motion carried.

<u>Final Action on SB54-Updating methods of mailing notice of termination of coverage of motor vehicle liability insurance policies.</u>

David Wiese explained the bill and the Chair called for final action.

A balloon amendment was distributed and discussed

The balloon removes the contents of **SB54**, and inserts the contents of **HB2021**, as modified by the house committee to clarify the definition of a program participant, removes the definition of commissioner and insert the definition of secretary and replaces references in the bill to commissioner with secretary to require the development and implementation of a process to convert leave and pay the cost of program participants contributions to the SEHP. The balloon creates a substitute bill, **House Substitute for SB54**.

Representative Hawkins moved, seconded by Representative Hill, to adopt the balloon amendment. Motion carried.
