Chairperson Johnson advised the Committee there is a change in the agenda for today regarding **HB2287**. Due to a scheduling conflict, the conferee requested a change in the hearing date for **HB2287** which will be Monday, March 16. In addition, on Friday, March 13, the Committee will take possible action on **SB228** and **HB2095**, the bond bill which has been returned to the Committee. The Committee will look at the amendment for adjusting the employer contribution rate by amount of debit service in fiscal year 2016 for **HB2095**.

The other issue in the Committee still under consideration is **HB2253** the Working after Retirement bill extending the sunset to July 01, 2018.

Following are some general thoughts regarding **HB2253**:

- 1. Retire/un-retire option.
 - If retirant decides to return to work, KPERS benefit would stop.
 - Employer contribution would continue.
 - Ouestion is what to do with employee contribution.
 - Should they contribute and get more years of service?
 - Should employee go into Tier 3 Cash Balance Plan?
- 2. Does it address the IRS concern and if a risk to the KPERS plan.
- 3. Addresses cost.
- 4. Flexibility for the employers to be able to hire.
- 5. Extending Earnings limitations.
