



## Kansas National Guard Rehabilitation and Repair Fund Request Current Challenges:

- Correction of Labor Charges to increase State Share being implemented for FY16. Past years 100% federally reimbursed State employees performed work at 50/50 State Armories and recent audits require a "fix". – Additional SGF Liability
- 2. Westar provides electricity to over 90% of KSNG facilities anticipate rate increase of 5+% by end of November 2015.
- 3. FY15 Project Imbalance (limited State General Funds)
  - a. 100% Federally Funded Projects \$7.9M
  - b. 50/50 Funded Projects \$800K (Total approx. \$400K SGF)
