The agency was told to reappropriate the \$33,374 into the FY2017 capital improvements budget. This accounts for the deviation from the usually \$250,000 emergency and rehabilitation repairs allocation in FY2016 and FY2017.

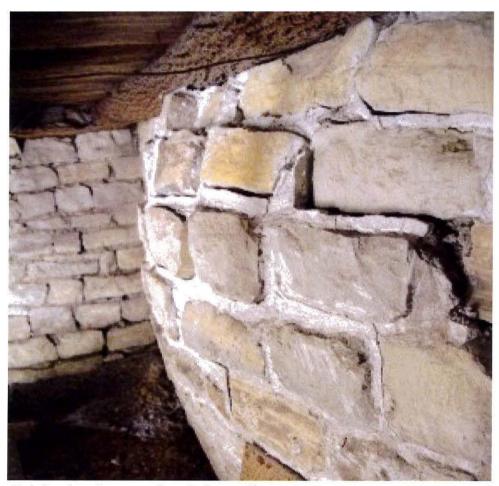

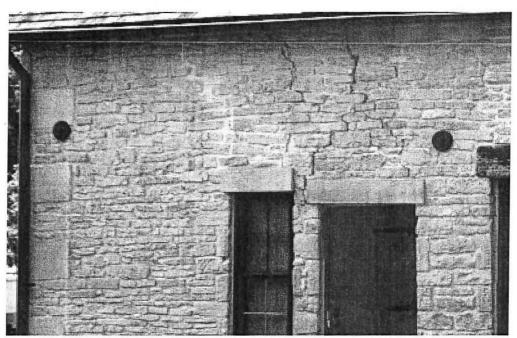

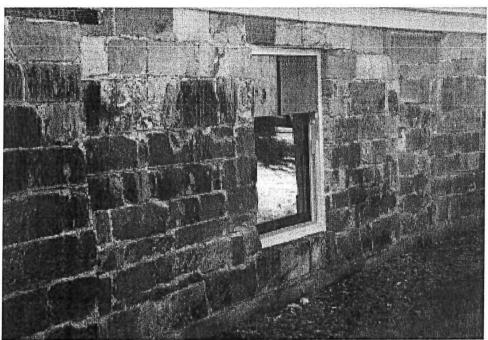
