Hearing on: HB2353 — Eliminating an obsolete reference to nonproficient pupils in the virtual school act.

Chairperson Abrams opened the hearing on **HB2353** and asked Jason Long, staff revisor, to review the bill for the Committee. Mr. Long reported this is a very brief cleanup bill from **HB2506** of last year. Policy provisions were changed in that bill, however, the area of non-proficient virtual school weighting was not covered. This bill would eliminate non-proficient pupils in determining the virtual school aid calculation. There were no questions for the revisor.

Since there were no conferees signed up to testify, the chairperson asked if anyone in the audience would like to speak to this bill. No one came forward.
