

Update as of January 31, 2016

The Kansas Reading Success Program was announced and launched October 5, 2015 after the beginning of the current school year.

In 117 days (approx. 4 months) since the launch date, Istation has been able to achieve the following:

- 124 districts have signed up for Istation Reading.
- 104 districts have actually sent in their rosters and enrolled 55,839 students in the Istation Reading Program as of today. The additional 20 districts who have signed up are in the process of sending to Istation their students rosters in the next couple weeks for additional enrollment representing another 18,000 to 20,000 students.
- 29% of the enrolled students have begun using the Istation Reading program.
- Each day another 2 – 3 districts are signing up for Istation as part of the Kansas Reading Success Program.
- Mass communications, PR releases, personal communications are continuing to go to all District Superintendents, Asst Superintendents, Principals and Asst Principals. Istation has boots-on-the-ground and have had meetings with numerous large districts.
- Istation attended the Kansas Statewide Superintendent conference on October 25 and October 26 and gained a lot of excitement and recognition.
- Eleven (11) full day on-site trainings and twenty-nine (29) webinars have already been provided to districts in order to educate districts, campuses and teachers about Istation and the reading program. These are gaining a great deal of excitement and momentum.
- Istation is successful partnering and working through Beth Fultz, Asst Director of Assessment and Accountability and she has assigned Jackie Lakin as the project manager to work with Istation.

The #1 question Istation receives from districts in Kansas who are considering signing up to use Istation Reading through the statewide program:

“Is the funding going to continue for subsequent years, because I don’t want to start a program that will not continue”.
