Balloon Amendments for SB 323 #1 Senate Committee on Education Prepared by Jason Long Office of Revisor of Statutes February 2, 2016

The board of education of each school district shall provide suicide awareness and prevention programming to all school staff. Such programming shall include, at a minimum:

- (1) At least one hour of training each calendar year based on programs approved by the state board of education. Such training may be satisfied through independent self-review of suicide prevention training materials; and
- (2) a building crisis plan developed for each school building. Such plan shall include:
  - (A) Steps for recognizing suicide ideation;
  - (B) appropriate methods of interventions; and
  - (C) a crisis recovery plan.
