Introduction of Committee Members

Chairman Holmes welcomed returning members and Senate President Wagle as a new member to the committee.

Introduction of Committee Rules

Chairman Holmes introduced the Committee Rules for the 2015 Session. (Attachment 1) He noted the following rules:

- #8 Inappropriate questioning could be asking an opinion of a staff member, questioning the conferee on the wrong subject or hostile questioning.
- #4 He will ask for objections on bill introductions and if none are presented, the introduction will be allowed "without objection".
- #5 Bill introductions will require a RS#. Exceptions could be made such as talking with the Chairman about an idea before committee.
- #15 Staff as well as the committee assistant may record votes.

Bill introductions

Chairman Holmes opened the floor for bill introductions. The Chairman introduced:

- *Raising expenditures from \$100 to \$500 in a calendar year before the person must meet the requirements of a lobbyist..
- *Charitable contributions, raising the threshold before local finance campaign reports are required, and a death provision to disperse of campaign fund accounts.
- *Allowing campaign contributions to be used for spouses in certain instances.

As there were no objections, the bills were introduced.
