Chairman Holmes gave a presentation on the Interim Committee's study regarding the feasibility of moving local city, county, and school district elections to coincide with the November elections to members of the Senate Ethics and Elections Committee and the House Elections Committee.

The Pros and Cons of Even year elections and the Pros and Cons of Odd year elections were conferred. He shared information that the Interim Committee received in presentations by the following: National Conference of State Legislatures; Presidential Commission on Election Administration/Maricopa County -Tammy Patrick; League of Kansas Municipalities; Secretary of State Kris Kobach; E S& S Corporation, an election equipment vendor; Two Panel Discussions from Nebraska and Utah involving multiple County Clerks and State Level Election Officer; Three Kansas Election Officials - Brian Newby of Johnson County, Jamie Shew of Douglas County and Sarah Rains of Hodgeman County, and Sarah Anzia, Ph.D. - author of "Timing and Turnout: How Off-Cycle Elections Favor Organized Groups".
