Chairman Holmes opened the meeting to continue discussion on <u>SB171 - Elections; municipalities</u> and special districts; spring to fall; other changes.

Senator Wolf moved to withdraw her amendment on **SB171** concerning ballot procedures from Wednesday's meeting with permission of the second, Senator Faust-Goudeau.

Senator Wolf moved a conceptual amendment to **SB171** striking randomize alphabet pertaining to ballot procedures from the bill. Seconded by Senator Fitzgerald. Motion carried.

<u>Senator Haley moved a conceptual amendment to SB171 to have the governing body of any</u> <u>municipality where a vacancy exists to appoint, by majority vote of the remaining members, a person to fill the vacancy within 30 days of the vacancy. Seconded by Senator Faust-Goudeau. Motion failed.</u>

<u>Senator Faust-Goudeau moved a conceptual amendment to **SB171** extending the time in the polling booth to ten minutes. Seconded by Senator Arpke. Motion carried.</u>

<u>Senator Fitzgerald moved **SB171** favorable for passage as amended. Seconded by Senator Arpke.</u>
<u>Motion failed.</u>

<u>Senator Wolf moved to reconsider the previous action. Seconded by Senator Arpke. Motion carried.</u> Back on <u>SB171</u>.

Senator O'Donnell moved to strike odd-numbered year from **SB171** as previously amended. Motion died for lack of second.
