Discussion & possible action on: SB42 — Governmental ethics; public funds used for lobbying.

The meeting was convened when a quorum was reached.

A brief explanation of the bill was given by Mike Heim, Office of the Revisor of Statutes.

Senator Fitzgerald moved to amend **SB42** with the following amendments: 1) Insert "person who is registered as a" in Section 1. line 5 after Every, 2) "shall file" line 5 after state, 3) Strike lines 21-23, and 4) Strike in line 24 "having the authority to levy and collect taxes". Seconded by Senator Love. Motion carried. (Attachment 1)

Chairman Holmes asked for an explanation of the proposed amendments by the revisor. Discussion followed on the bill.

<u>Chairman Holmes moved a conceptual amendment to SB42 by adding the word "lobbying" before the word "services" in line 8. Seconded by Senator Fitzgerald. Motion carried.</u>

<u>Chairman Holmes made a conceptual motion to modify his previous motion by reinserting the definition of lobbying in lines 21-23. Seconded by Senator Fitzgerald. Motion carried.</u>

There was no further discussion on the bill.
