## <u>Hearing on: HB2183 — Political campaigns and use of technology.</u>

Chairman Holmes opened the hearing on **HB2183**.

Carol Williams, Executive Director of the Kansas Governmental Ethics Commission, appeared before the committee in a neutral position on <a href="HB2183">HB2183</a>. (Attachment 1) This bill amends three provisions in the Campaign Finance Act to address the use of social media in politics. Section 1 of the bill is amended to allow a general public solicitation for campaign contributions during session not targeted toward a specific individual when using social media. Section 2 provides new language permitting a Twitter communication to be tweeted without the required "paid for by" attribution statement on the tweet. And section 3 addresses the use of any wifi network provided by the state of Kansas or any municipality by a candidate or elected official. Executive Director Williams stood for questions from the committee.

There being no further conferees, the hearing on **HB2183** closed.
