<u>Hearing continuation on: SB410 — Establishing a CARE family pilot program for foster care.</u>

Chair King called the meeting to order. He reconvened the hearing on **SB410**, and called Tom Witt to testify.

Mr. Witt presented neutral testimony regarding **SB410**. He related that gay and lesbian households adopt and foster at up to four times the average rate. He further explained that the requirement in the bill that a couple be married for at least seven years may raise some equal protection problems, because couples barred from marriage for the last seven years in Kansas would not be able to take advantage of this program, should they desire to. Mr. Witt answered questions from Senator Pettey.

Chair King called the committee's attention to the neutral written-only testimony of Jaime Rogers, Prevention and Protection Services, Interim Director, Kansas DCF. (Attachment 2)
