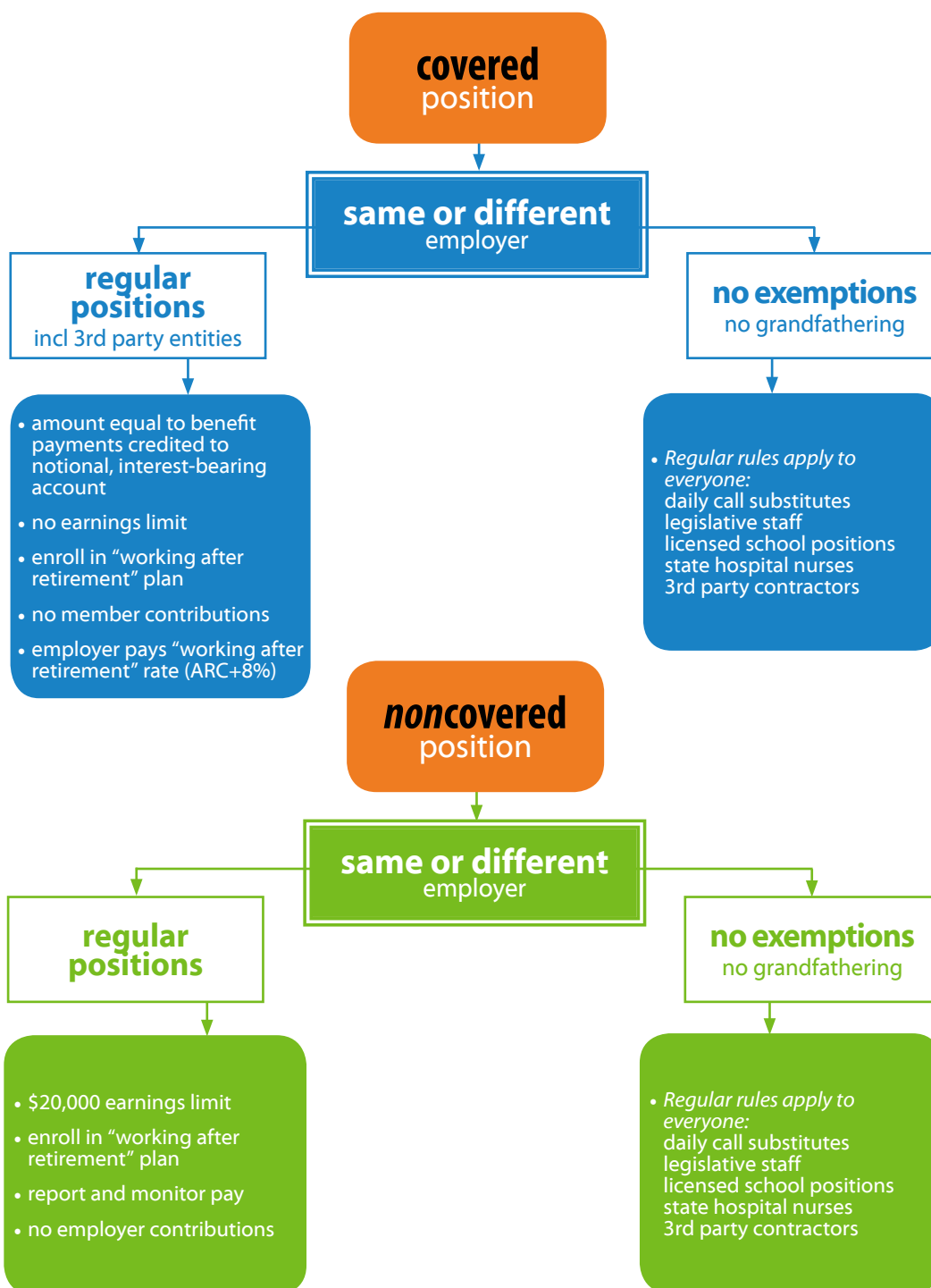


Working After Retirement Flowchart

Based on SB 299 as introduced, for all KPERS employers and members



Good to Know

1. Senate Bill 299 as introduced. Effective date July 1, 2016.
2. Covered position is one that is permanent, covered by Social Security and meets minimum hours. (School = 630/year; Nonschool=1,000/year) All other positions are considered "noncovered" for KPERS purposes.
3. The Kansas House is currently has its own version of working after retirement rules, HB 2253 as amended by the House Pensions and Benefits Committee.
