Chairman Powell turned the Committee's attention to **SB384-Amending provisions of the non-game** and endangered species conservation act.

Aaron Popelka, Kansas Livestock Association, explained the bill as clarifying administration functions and permit rules. Steve Adams, Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, clarified what certification includes for registration in the conservation program.

<u>Senator Smith moved the balloon amendment, striking critical habitat, endangered and threatened</u> <u>species, and exclusion of certification or registration. Senator Francisco seconded the motion. Motion adopted.</u>

Chairman Powell turned the Committee's attention to <u>HB2059-Creating an application requirement</u> and fee to appropriate water that otherwise leaves the state and creating a chemigation permit exception.

<u>Senator Kerschen moved to adopt the balloon amendment. Senator Tyson seconded the motion. Motion adopted.</u>

<u>Senator Ostmeyer moved, Senator Kerschen seconded to recommend amended **HB2059** for favorable passage. Motion adopted.</u>

<u>Senator Pyle moved a motion to reconsider **HB2059**. The motion failed for lack of a second. (Attachment 3)</u>
