# **Informational hearing:**

Chairperson Pilcher-Cook opened the informational hearing on Charity Care.

Andrew Brown, FGA, provided information on a program called Volunteer Care which provides healthcare to the uninsured, the under-insured, and individuals who live in under-served areas of the community. Mr. Brown indicated that it's a two-step solution: provide medical professionals with liability protection for providing care to qualified patients; and, allow them to receive Continuing Medical Education credits for their volunteerism. Mr. Brown stated that they believe Volunteer Care is a valuable tool that can be added to the tools that are already being used to improve access to quality medical care for the most needy Kansans.
