Final action on: SB43 — Home on the range highway.

Chairman Petersen called for Final Action on <u>SB 43</u>. After a brief explanation by Adam Siebers, Assistant Revisor, the Chair reminded the Committee that the funding was included in this bill and that it was the desire of the originator to keep the bill clean for the Governor's signing ceremony. <u>Moved by Senator Schmidt</u>, <u>seconded by Senator Pettey</u>, that <u>SB 43</u> be passed and due to its non-controversial nature be placed on the consent calendar. <u>Motion passed</u>.

Final action on: SB73 — Definitions of certain vehicles.

Chairman Petersen called for Final Action on <u>SB 73</u>. Following a brief explanation of the bill by Adam Siebers, Assistant Revisor, <u>it was moved by Senator Schmidt</u>, <u>seconded by Senator King that SB 73 be passed</u>, and due to its non-controversial nature be placed on the consent calendar. Motion carried.

<u>Final action on: SB68 — George Ablah expressway.</u>

Following a brief explanation of the bill by Adam Siebers, Assistant Revisor, Chairman Petersen called for Final Action on **SB 68**. *It was moved by Senator Wolf, seconded by Senator Donovan that SB 68 be passed and due to its non-controversial nature be placed on the consent calendar. After a brief discussion, Senator Wolf withdrew her motion, with the approval of Senator Donovan.*

Final action on: SB139 — Mayor Ken Bernard memorial highway.

Mr. Siebers reviewed <u>SB 139</u> for the Committee. Following guidelines provided by Jill Shelley, Legislative Research, from the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, <u>it was moved by Senator King, seconded by Senator Fitzgerald, to amend SB 139 by removing the title "mayor" and amending the sign to read the "Kenneth W. Bernard Memorial Highway". Motion carried. It was further moved by Senator Fitzgerald, seconded by Senator King, that the amended contents of SB 139 be inserted into SB 68 and that SB 68, as amended, be moved out favorably for passage. Motion carried.</u>
