

**HOUSE BILL No. 2504**

AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2002, and June 30, 2003, for the department of commerce and housing for the Kansas Lewis & Clark bicentennial commission; concerning the powers and duties of the secretary of commerce.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

Section 1. The secretary of the department of commerce and housing is hereby authorized and empowered to accept donations, gifts, bequests or other contributions to be used in furthering the commemoration of the Lewis & Clark bicentennial in Kansas. All contributions so received shall be remitted to the state treasurer at least monthly. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount thereof in the state treasury and shall credit the same to the Kansas Lewis & Clark bicentennial account in the state treasury, which account is hereby created. All expenditures from such account shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary of the department of commerce and housing or the secretary's designee.

**DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND HOUSING**

(a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general fund for the fiscal years or years specified, the following:

Kansas Lewis & Clark bicentennial commission  
For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002..... \$25,000  
*Provided*, That any unencumbered balance in the Kansas Lewis & Clark bicentennial commission account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2002, is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2003.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
