12 AN ACT concerning certain commissions and councils; relating to the
13 membership thereof; amending K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-9201 and 75-
14 7202 and repealing the existing sections.

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16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

17 Section 1. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-9201 is hereby amended to read as
18 follows: 74-9201. (a) There is hereby established the Kansas film serv-
19 ices commission. The commission shall consist of 19 voting members as
20 follows: (1) One member of the senate appointed by the president of the
21 senate; (2) one member of the senate appointed by the minority leader
22 of the senate; (3) one member of the house of representatives appointed
23 by the speaker of the house of representatives; (4) one member of the
24 house of representatives appointed by the minority leader of the house
25 of representatives; and (5) fifteen members appointed by the governor.
26 One of the members appointed by the governor shall be appointed from
27 each tourism region recognized and designated as a tourism region by
28 the secretary of commerce and housing. All members appointed by the
29 governor shall be appointed for terms of three years, except that of the
30 members first appointed, five shall be appointed for one-year terms, five
31 shall be appointed for two-year terms and five shall be appointed for
32 three-year terms. The governor shall designate the term for which each
33 of the members first appointed shall serve. In addition to the voting mem-
34 bers of the commission, six members of the commission shall serve ex
35 officio: The secretary of commerce and housing, the secretary of trans-
36 portation, the secretary of wildlife and parks, the secretary of health and
37 environment, the executive director of the Kansas arts commission and
38 the secretary of the state historical society. Each ex officio member of
39 the commission may designate an officer or employee of the state agency
40 of the ex officio member to serve on the commission in place of the ex
41 officio member. The ex officio members of the commission, or their des-
42 ignees, shall be nonvoting members of the commission and shall provide
43 information and advice to the commission. In addition to the voting and

1 ex officio members of the commission, the governor may appoint such
2 number of representatives of the film industry to nonvoting membership
3 on the commission as may be recommended by the secretary of com-
4 merce and housing.

5 (b) Legislative members shall be appointed for terms coinciding with
6 the terms for which such members are elected. ~~All legislative members
7 and members appointed by the governor shall serve without compensa-
8 tion.~~ All members appointed to fill vacancies in the membership of the
9 commission and all members appointed to succeed members appointed
10 to membership on the commission shall be appointed in like manner as
11 that provided for the original appointment of the member succeeded. All
12 members appointed to fill vacancies of a member of the commission ap-
13 pointed by the governor shall be appointed to fill the unexpired term of
14 such member.

15 (c) The members of the commission shall elect annually a chairper-
16 son and vice-chairperson for the commission from among its members.
17 The commission shall meet at least four times each year at the call of the
18 chairperson of the commission. Ten voting members of the commission
19 shall constitute a quorum.

20 (d) *Members of the commission **who are not legislators** shall receive*
21 *compensation, subsistence allowances, mileage and other expenses [mile-*
22 *age, tolls and parking] as provided in K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments*
23 *thereto, for attendance at any meeting of the commission or any subcom-*
24 *mittee meeting authorized by the commission. **Legislative members of***
25 ***the commission shall be paid amounts provided in subsection (e) of***
26 ***K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments thereto, for attendance at any***
27 ***meeting of the commission or any subcommittee meeting authorized***
28 ***by the commission.***

29 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 75-7202 is hereby amended to read as
30 follows: 75-7202. (a) There is hereby established the information tech-
31 nology executive council which shall be attached to the department of
32 administration for purposes of administrative functions.

33 (b) The council shall be composed of 17 voting members as follows:
34 The secretary of administration; two cabinet agency heads; one nonca-
35 binet agency head; the director of the budget; the executive chief infor-
36 mation technology officer; the legislative chief information technology
37 officer; the judicial chief information technology officer and the judicial
38 administrator of the Kansas supreme court; the executive director of the
39 Kansas board of regents; the commissioner of education; one represen-
40 tative of cities; one representative of counties; the network manager of
41 the information network of Kansas (INK); and three representatives from
42 the private sector who are chief executive officers or chief information
43 technology officers. The chief information technology architect shall be

1 a nonvoting member of the council. The two cabinet agency heads, the
2 noncabinet agency head, the representative of cities, the representative
3 of counties and the representatives from the private sector shall be ap-
4 pointed by the governor for a term not to exceed 18 months. Upon ex-
5 piration of an appointed member's term, the member shall continue to
6 hold office until the appointment of a successor. Nonappointed members
7 shall serve *ex officio*.

8 (c) The secretary of administration shall serve as the chairperson of
9 the council.

10 (d) The council shall hold meetings and hearings in the city of To-
11 peka or at such other places as the council designates, on call of the
12 chairperson or on request of four or more members.

13 (e) Members of the council may not appoint an individual to rep-
14 resent them on the council and only members of the council may vote.

15 (f) Members of the council shall ~~not be eligible for receive~~ **not be**
16 **eligible for** ~~compensation, subsistence allowances, mileage or and other~~
17 ~~expenses as provided~~ **receive [mileage, tolls and parking as provided]**
18 in K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments thereto, for attendance at any meet-
19 ing of the council or any subcommittee meeting authorized by the council,
20 ~~except that agencies may pay subsistence, mileage and other expenses to~~
21 ~~their representatives on the council.~~

22 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 74-9201 and 75-7202 are hereby repealed.

23 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
24 publication in the Kansas register.

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
