10 AN ACT concerning campaign finance; establishing requirements for
11 electronic filing of reporting of campaign contributions.

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13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) From and after January 1, 2002, every treasurer for
15 a candidate for statewide office **receiving contributions in excess of**
16 **\$30,000 during the reporting period** shall file all **such** reports of cam-
17 paign contributions required by K.S.A. 25-4148, and amendments
18 thereto, with the secretary of state by electronic means as prescribed by
19 this act.

20 (b) (1) In addition to the reports required by K.S.A. 25-4148, and
21 amendments thereto, there shall be a report concerning campaign con-
22 tributions **in an aggregate amount of \$500 or more** received during
23 the period commencing 11 days before a primary or general election at
24 which a statewide officer is to be elected and ending upon the day of
25 such election, the report shall contain the name and address of each
26 person who has made one or more **such** contributions ~~in an aggregate~~
27 ~~amount or value in excess of \$50~~. Such report shall be filed with the
28 secretary of state on or before the close of the next business day in which
29 any such contribution is received. The report **also** shall contain the
30 amount and date of such contribution, including the name and address
31 of every lender, guarantor and endorser when the contribution is in the
32 form of an advance or loan. Reports required by this section shall be in
33 addition to and not in lieu of any other report required by law.

34 (2) All other reports concerning reporting of campaign contributions
35 for statewide office shall be filed within the time period **and in the man-**
36 **ner** prescribed by law.

37 Sec. 2. No provision of this act shall preclude the filing by electronic
38 means any other report required by the campaign finance act.

39 Sec. 3. (a) The secretary of state shall adopt rules and regulations
40 establishing a program for the electronic filing of any report required by
41 this act. Such program may contain criteria for:

- 42 (1) Computer hardware, software or other equipment to be used; and
43 (2) any other matters necessary to implement the provisions of this

1 act.

2 (b) The rules and regulations required by this section shall be prom-
3 ulgated, published and become effective no later than ~~July 1~~ **January 10,**
4 2002.

5 Sec. 4. The provisions of this act shall be part of and supplemental
6 to the campaign finance act.

7 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
8 publication in the Kansas register.

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
