10 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years end-
11 ing June 30, 2001, June 30, 2002, and June 30, 2003, for state agencies;
12 authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees,
13 imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or author-
14 izing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the
15 foregoing.

17 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

18 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2001, June 30, 2002,
19 and June 30, 2003, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and lim-
20 itations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects,
21 fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are
22 hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

23 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
24 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized
25 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to
26 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

27 (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
28 K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto.

30 STATE FAIR BOARD

31 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following spe-
32 cial revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, all
33 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund
34 or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law
35 shall not exceed the following:

36 State fair capital improvements fund No limit
37 SBSF—encampment building renovation fund No limit

38 (b) On or before the 10th of each month during the fiscal year ending
39 June 30, 2002, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from
40 the state general fund to the state fair capital improvements fund interest
41 earnings based on: (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the state
42 fair capital improvements fund for the preceding month; and (2) the net
43 earnings rate for the pooled money investment portfolio for the preceding

1 month.

2 (c) On July 1, 2001, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer
3 all moneys in the EDIF—capital improvements fund of the state fair
4 board, to the state economic development initiatives fund. On July 1,
5 2001, all liabilities of the EDIF—capital improvements fund of the state
6 fair board, including any outstanding encumbrances, are hereby trans-
7 ferred to and imposed on the state economic development initiatives fund
8 and the EDIF—capital improvements fund of the state fair board is
9 hereby abolished.

24 habilitation services other than any institution, as defined by K.S.A. 76-
25 12a01 or 76-12a18 and amendments thereto.
