10 AN ACT relating to public officers; enacting the constitutional awareness
11 act.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the consti-
15 tutional awareness act.

16 Sec. 2. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, the office of
17 the secretary of state shall ~~provide~~ ***make available*** to each candidate
18 for state office and each person appointed to a state office a copy of each
19 of the following documents:

- 20 (1) The constitution of the United States;
21 (2) The constitution of the state of Kansas;
22 (3) the current examination for United States citizenship used by the
23 immigration and naturalization service; and
24 (4) the answer sheet or other listing of the correct answers for the
25 document listed in paragraph (3).

26 (b) As used in this section, "state office" means the office of governor,
27 lieutenant governor, secretary of state, attorney general, state treasurer,
28 commissioner of insurance, state senator, state representative, member
29 of the state board of education and any appointive office for which the
30 appointment is subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A.
31 75-4315b and amendments thereto.

32 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
33 publication in the statute book.
