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10 AN ACT concerning pregnancy-related instruction by certain institu-

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14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

16 (1) "Abortion" or "abortion procedure" means any surgical or other  
17 procedure or drug used to terminate a pregnancy, whether the fetus is  
18 viable or not.

19 (2) "Institution" means any secondary school, college, university,  
20 community college or other organization, institution or agency which re-  
21 ceives public moneys.

22 (3) "Pregnancy related instruction" means a course, special event,  
23 seminar or forum on any or all of the following topics: Birth control,  
24 human reproduction, human sexuality and sex education.

25 (b) Whenever any institution offers pregnancy-related instruction,  
26 there shall be included in such instruction information and materials spe-  
27 cifically addressing human fetal development and gestation. Such infor-  
28 mation and materials shall describe and anatomical and physiological  
29 characteristics of the fetus at four-week gestational increments from fer-  
30 tilization to full term, including pictures or realistic drawings, or both,  
31 giving actual size dimensions. Such information and materials shall be  
32 objective, ~~nonjudgmental~~ and designed to convey only accurate scientific  
33 information about the fetus at various gestational stages and about the  
34 medical benefits and risks of carrying the fetus to term.

35 (c) Whenever any pregnancy-related instruction discusses abortion,  
36 such information shall include a description of all methods of abortion,  
37 including, but not limited to: (1) Morning after pill; (2) suction abortion;  
38 (3) RU 486/methotrexate; (4) dilation and extraction; (5) salt abortion; (6)  
39 prostaglandin; and (7) partial birth. The information and materials shall  
40 be objective, ~~nonjudgmental~~ and designed to convey only accurate sci-  
41 entific information about the medical risks associated with each proce-  
42 dure as well as information concerning the fetal development at the time  
43 of each procedure. Such fetal information shall include the probable phys-

1 ical sensations or pain a fetus feels or detects, or may feel or detect, during  
2 the various abortion procedures. Such fetal information shall also include  
3 relevant information on the survival of the fetus, if the fetus is not killed  
4 during an abortion procedure.

5 (d) The method of implementing this act shall be determined by the  
6 governing body of the institution. ~~Failure to implement this act will result~~  
7 ~~in a 2% reduction in the state aid allocated to the institution in the first~~  
8 ~~year following the infraction. Subsequent failures will result in a 2% re-~~  
9 ~~duction in state aid in each following year.~~
