10 AN ACT establishing the school district interlocal cooperation for the
11 sharing of administrative staff grant program; providing for a stan-
12 dardized financial report.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. There is established the school district interlocal cooper-
16 ation for the sharing of administrative staff grant program. The purpose
17 of the program is to reward school districts that enter into interlocal co-
18 operation agreements in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 72-
19 8230, and amendments thereto, for the purpose of jointly and cooperat-
20 ively sharing the services of a superintendent of schools and assistant
21 superintendents appointed under authority of K.S.A. 72-8202b, and
22 amendments thereto. Each school district that enters into such an inter-
23 local cooperation agreement is entitled to receive a grant of state moneys
24 in an amount to be computed by the state board of education as follows:

25 (a) Determine the total amount budgeted in the school year preced-
26 ing the school year in which the interlocal cooperation agreement is en-
27 tered by the school districts party to the agreement for the salaries of the
28 superintendents and assistant superintendents employed by such school
29 districts;

30 (b) determine the amount budgeted under the interlocal cooperation
31 agreement for the salaries of the jointly shared superintendent and assis-
32 tant superintendents;

33 (c) subtract the amount determined under (b) from the amount de-
34 termined under (a);

35 (d) divide the remainder obtained under (c) by the number of school
36 districts party to the interlocal cooperation agreement. The amount of
37 the quotient is the amount of the grant each school district is entitled to
38 receive for the school year and for the two next succeeding school years.
39 Upon receipt of a grant of state moneys under this section, the amount
40 of the grant shall be deposited in or credited to any program weighted
41 fund or any categorical fund of the district.

42 Sec. 2. Each school district shall report financial data, including the
43 district budget, on a standard form established by the state board of

1 education.

2 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
3 publication in the statute book.
