

## House Concurrent Resolution No. 5048

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A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION establishing a joint committee on Kansas security.

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the Senate concurring therein:* That a joint committee on Kansas security be established to study measures and their advisability for the improvement of security for Kansas; and

*Be it further resolved:* That the joint committee on Kansas security shall consist of 23 members appointed as follows: Seven members appointed by the President of the Senate and 16 members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Two of the Senate members appointed shall be of the minority party and six of the Representative members appointed shall be of the minority party. In the first year of the joint committee, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate a Representative member to be the chairperson and the President of the Senate shall designate a Senate member to be vice-chairperson from the adoption of this resolution until the convening of the regular session of 2003. In the second year of the joint committee, the President of the Senate shall designate a Senate member to be chairperson and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate a Representative member to be vice-chairperson; and

*Be it further resolved:* That the joint committee on Kansas security shall meet on call of the chairperson during the regular session of the legislature and on call of the chairperson as authorized by the legislative coordinating council during such other times; and

*Be it further resolved:* That the joint committee on Kansas security shall be deemed a select committee for the purposes of subsection (c) of Joint Rule 4 and the joint committee on Kansas security may introduce such legislation as it deems necessary; and

*Be it further resolved:* That members of the joint committee on Kansas security, after *sine die* adjournment of the legislature, shall receive reimbursement for attending meetings of the joint committee authorized by the Legislative Coordinating Council consistent with the provisions of K.S.A. 46-1209, and amendments thereto; and

*Be it further resolved:* That the joint committee on Kansas security

2 Legislature and submit a final report and recommendations to the 2004
