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14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

16 (1) "Electric public utility" has the meaning provided by K.S.A. 66-
17 101a, and amendments thereto.

18 (2) [**"Renewable attributes" means tradeable renewable en-**
19 **ergy credits (with or without other features), tradeable emissions**
20 **credits, emission offsets or other market instruments created or**
21 **obtained by use of renewable energy resources or technologies.**

22 [(3)] "Renewable resources or technologies" means wind, solar, ther-
23 mal, photovoltaic, biomass, hydropower, geothermal, waste incineration
24 and landfill gas resources or technologies located in Kansas.

25 (b) Upon application of an electric public utility, the state corporation
26 commission may authorize such utility to:

27 (1) Retain 65% of the utility's net revenues from wholesale off-system
28 sales of electricity generated from renewable resources or technologies
29 [**or from sales of renewable attributes**] if such electricity ~~is~~ [**or at-**
30 **tributes are**] purchased by the utility at not less than the average price
31 paid by such utility for electricity [**or renewable attributes**] purchased
32 pursuant to contracts of five or more years' duration; and

33 (2) retain 50% of the utility's net revenues from all other wholesale
34 off-system sales of purchased electricity generated from renewable re-
35 sources or technologies [**or from sales of purchased renewable**
36 **attributes**].
