10 AN ACT concerning state finance; maximum expenditures and demand  
11 transfers from the state general fund; amending K.S.A. 75-6702 and  
12 repealing the existing section.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. K.S.A. 75-6702 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-  
16 6702. (a) The last appropriation bill passed in any regular session of the  
17 legislature shall be the omnibus reconciliation spending limit bill. Each  
18 bill which is passed during a regular session of the legislature and which  
19 appropriates or transfers money from the state general fund for the en-  
20 suing fiscal year shall contain a provision that such bill shall take effect  
21 and be in force from and after the effective date of the omnibus recon-  
22 ciliation spending limit bill for that regular session of the legislature or  
23 from and after such effective date and a subsequent date or an event  
24 occurring after such effective date.

25 (b) *The maximum amounts of expenditures and demand transfers*  
26 *from the state general fund that may be authorized by act of the legislature*  
27 *are hereby fixed for the fiscal years specified, as follows:*

28 (1) *The maximum amount of expenditures and demand transfers from*  
29 *the state general fund that may be authorized by act of the legislature*  
30 *during the 2002 regular session of the legislature is hereby fixed so that*  
31 *there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for the ensuing*  
32 *fiscal year that is equal to 5% or more of the total amount authorized to*  
33 *be expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general*  
34 *fund in such fiscal year;*

35 (2) *the maximum amount of expenditures and demand transfers from*  
36 *the state general fund that may be authorized by act of the legislature*  
37 *during the 2003 regular session of the legislature is hereby fixed so that*  
38 *there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for the ensuing*  
39 *fiscal year that is equal to 5.5% or more of the total amount authorized*  
40 *to be expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general*  
41 *fund in such fiscal year;*

42 (3) *the maximum amount of expenditures and demand transfers from*  
43 *the state general fund that may be authorized by act of the legislature*

1 *during the 2004 regular session of the legislature is hereby fixed so that*  
2 *there will be an ending balance in the state general fund for the ensuing*  
3 *fiscal year that is equal to 6% or more of the total amount authorized to*  
4 *be expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general*  
5 *fund in such fiscal year; and*

6 (4) the maximum amount of expenditures and demand transfers from  
7 the state general fund that may be authorized by act of the legislature  
8 during the ~~1994~~ 2005 regular session of the legislature and each regular  
9 session of the legislature thereafter, is hereby fixed so that there will be  
10 an ending balance in the state general fund for the ensuing fiscal year  
11 that is equal to ~~7½%~~ 7.5% or more of the total amount authorized to be  
12 expended or transferred by demand transfer from the state general fund  
13 in such fiscal year.

14 ***(c) On and after the effective date of this act, if in any fiscal***  
15 ***year the requirements of subsection (b) of this section are not met,***  
16 ***the director of the Kansas legislative research department shall no-***  
17 ***tify in writing each member of the legislature that such require-***  
18 ***ments have not been met on or before 10 days following sine die of***  
19 ***such fiscal year.***

20 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 75-6702 is hereby repealed.

21 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
22 publication in the Kansas register.
