10 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years end-
11 ing June 30, 2002, and June 30, 2003, for state agencies; authorizing
12 certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees, imposing cer-
13 tain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain
14 receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing.
15

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

17 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2002, and June 30,
18 2003, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are
19 hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, re-
20 cepts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby di-
21 rected or authorized as provided in this act.

22 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
23 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized
24 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to
25 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

26 (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
27 K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto.

29 **STATE FAIR BOARD**

30 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following
31 special revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003,
32 all moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such
33 fund or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by
34 law shall not exceed the following:

35 State fair capital improvements fund No limit

36 (b) On or before the 10th of each month during the fiscal year ending
37 June 30, 2003, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from
38 the state general fund to the state fair capital improvements fund interest
39 earnings based on: (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the state
40 fair capital improvements fund for the preceding month; and (2) the net
41 earnings rate for the pooled money investment portfolio for the preceding
42 month.

43 (c) During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, the director of ac-

1 counts and reports shall not make any transfer directed to be made by
 2 subsection (c) of K.S.A. 2-223 and amendments thereto from the state
 3 general fund to the state fair capital improvements fund of the state fair
 4 board. On July 1, 2002, or as soon as moneys are available, and notwith-
 5 standing the provisions of K.S.A. 2-223 and amendments thereto, the
 6 director of accounts and reports shall transfer from the state general fund
 7 to the state fair capital improvements fund of the state fair board the
 8 amount equal to the difference between \$300,000 and the amount cer-
 9 tified by the state fair board and transferred from the state fair fee fund
 10 to the state fair capital improvements fund pursuant to subsection (b) of
 11 K.S.A. 2-223 and amendments thereto.

13 DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL AND REHABILITATION SERVICES

14 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state insti-
 15 tutions building fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for the
 16 capital improvement project or projects specified as follows:

18 *Provided*, That the secretary of social and rehabilitation services is hereby
 19 authorized to transfer moneys during fiscal year 2003 from the rehabili-
 20 tation and repair projects account to a rehabilitation and repair account
 21 for any institution, as defined by K.S.A. 76-12a01 or 76-12a18 and amend-
 22 ments thereto, for projects approved by the secretary of social and re-
 23 habilitation services: *Provided further*, That expenditures also may be
 24 made from this account during fiscal year 2003 for the purposes of re-
 25 habilitation and repair for facilities of the department of social and re-
 26 habilitation services other than any institution, as defined by K.S.A. 76-
 27 12a01 or 76-12a18 and amendments thereto.

29 (b) In addition to the purposes for which expenditures may be made
 30 by the above agency from the other state fees fund for fiscal year 2003,
 31 expenditures may be made by the above agency from the other state fees
 32 fund for fiscal year 2003 for the following capital improvement project or
 33 projects, subject to the expenditure limitations prescribed therefor:

34 Area office rehabilitation and repair \$300,000

35 *Provided*, That expenditures from the area office rehabilitation and repair
 36 account shall be in addition to any expenditure limitation imposed on the
 37 other state fees fund for fiscal year 2003.

38 (c) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be
 39 made by the department of social and rehabilitation services from the
 40 moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special
 41 revenue fund for fiscal year 2003 as authorized by this or other appro-
 42 priation act of the 2002 regular session of the legislature, expenditures
 43 shall be made by the department of social and rehabilitation services from

1 moneys appropriated from the state general fund or from any special
 2 revenue fund for fiscal year 2003 to provide for the issuance of bonds by
 3 the Kansas development finance authority in accordance with K.S.A. 74-
 4 8905 and amendments thereto for a capital improvement project for con-
 5 struction of a new state security hospital on the Larned state hospital
 6 grounds: *Provided*, That the capital improvement project for construction
 7 of a new state security hospital on the Larned state hospital grounds is
 8 hereby approved for the department of social and rehabilitations services
 9 for the purposes of subsection (b) of K.S.A. 74-8905 and amendments
 10 thereto and the authorization of the issuance of bonds by the Kansas
 11 development finance authority in accordance with that statute: *Provided*
 12 *further*, That the department of social and rehabilitation services may
 13 make expenditures from the moneys received from the issuance of any
 14 such bonds for such capital improvement project: *Provided, however*,
 15 That expenditures from the moneys received from the issuance of any
 16 such bonds for such capital improvement project shall not exceed
 17 \$50,120,884, plus all amounts required for costs of bond issuance, costs
 18 of interest on the bonds issued for such capital improvement project dur-
 19 ing the construction of such project and any required reserves for the
 20 payment of principal and interest on the bonds: *And provided further*,
 21 That all moneys received from the issuance of any such bonds shall be
 22 deposited and accounted for as prescribed by applicable bond covenants:
 23 *And provided further*, That debt service for any such bonds for such
 24 capital improvement projects shall be financed by appropriations from
 25 the state institutions building fund or any other appropriate special rev-
 26 enue fund or funds.

27 (d) On the effective date of this act, any unencumbered balance in
 28 each of the following accounts of the state institutions building fund is
 29 hereby lapsed: Sex predator contingency fund.
