AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; concerning the installation of air bags.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person who, without the knowledge of the vehicle's owner or the person requesting the installation, reinstallation or replacement of a motor vehicle air bag, to install or reinstall any air bag or other component of the vehicle's inflatable restraint system knowing that the air bag installation is not in accordance with federal safety regulations applicable to that specific line-make, model, and model year vehicle and upon conviction shall be guilty of a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person who, without the knowledge of the vehicle's owner or the person requesting the installation, reinstallation or replacement of a motor vehicle air bag, to install, reinstall or replace a motor vehicle air bag or other component of the vehicle's inflatable restraint system with an air bag or other component of a vehicle's inflatable restraint system knowing that the air bag was previously installed in another motor vehicle and upon conviction shall be guilty of a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
