AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to classroom enhancements; creating the classroom enhancement fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. At the end of a school year, within budget limitations, the board of education of a school district may transfer from the general fund any amount of money into the classroom enhancement fund. There is hereby established in every district a fund which shall be called the classroom enhancement fund. The fund shall consist of all amounts deposited therein or credited thereto according to law. Amounts in the the classroom enhancement fund may be expended for any supplies related to teaching in the classroom. Any unexpended and unencumbered cash balance remaining in the classroom enhancement fund of a district at the conclusion of any school year may be maintained in such fund until budgeted and expended in a succeeding school year.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
