AN ACT relating to clerks of the district court; providing for disposition of certain vehicle registration fines.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. All moneys received by the clerk of the district court from the payment of fines for the failure of a resident of a county, as provided for in K.S.A. 8-1,138, and amendments thereto, to properly register such person's vehicles in accordance with the provisions of article 1 of chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, shall be remitted by the clerk of the district court as follows:

(a) To the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, for deposit in accordance with K.S.A. 20-350, and amendments thereto, an amount equal to 40% of each fine; and

(b) at least monthly to the county treasurer, for deposit in the county treasury and credit to the county general fund, an amount equal to 60% of each fine.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
