12 AN ACT concerning capital improvements for state agencies; making
13 and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending June 30,
14 2004, June 30, 2005, and June 30, 2006, for state agencies; authorizing
15 certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees, imposing cer-
16 tain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain
17 receipts, loans, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing.
18

19 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

20 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2004, June 30, 2005,
21 and June 30, 2006, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and lim-
22 itations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects,
23 fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are
24 hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

25 (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
26 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized
27 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to
28 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

29 (c) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
30 provisions of K.S.A. 46- 155 and amendments thereto.

32 STATE FAIR BOARD

33 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the following spe-
34 cial revenue fund or funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, all
35 moneys now or hereafter lawfully credited to and available in such fund
36 or funds, except that expenditures other than refunds authorized by law
37 shall not exceed the following:

38 State fair capital improvements fund No limit

39 (b) On or before the 10th of each month during the fiscal year ending
40 June 30, 2005, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer from
41 the state general fund to the state fair capital improvements fund interest
42 earnings based on: (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the state
43 fair capital improvements fund for the preceding month; and (2) the net

1 earnings rate for the pooled money investment portfolio for the preceding
2 month.

41 upon approval of the state board of regents, the president of Kansas state
