9 AN ACT concerning the membership of the state workforce investment  
10 board and local workforce investment boards; providing for an advisory  
11 committee to each local workforce investment board.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "older Kansan" has the mean-  
15 ing provided by K.S.A. 75-5741, and amendments thereto.

16 (b) The workforce network board of Kansas, designated as the state  
17 workforce investment board pursuant to Executive Order No. 01-06, or  
18 its successor, shall include: (1) One representative of nonprofit agencies  
19 and organizations and public bodies providing services to persons seeking  
20 employment through the older Kansans employment program; (2) one  
21 representative of area agencies on aging; and (3) one representative of  
22 the department of commerce.

23 (c) Each local workforce investment board shall include: (1) One rep-  
24 resentative of nonprofit agencies and organizations and public bodies pro-  
25 viding services to persons seeking employment through the older Kansans  
26 employment program; (2) one representative of area agencies on aging  
27 in the area served by the local workforce investment board; and (3) one  
28 older Kansan who has received assistance from a nonprofit agency or  
29 organization or public body providing services through the older Kansans  
30 employment program.

31 (d) Each local workforce investment board shall establish an advisory  
32 committee to review the board's service plans and the board's perform-  
33 ance regarding services provided to older Kansans seeking employment.  
34 The advisory committee shall report to the local workforce investment  
35 board and may confer with groups advocating for the well-being of older  
36 Kansans, the Kansas department on aging and area agencies on aging in  
37 the area served by the local workforce investment board.

38 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
39 publication in the statute book.
