9 A RESOLUTION urging the Congress of the United States to pass the  
10 RU-486 suspension and review act of 2003.

12 WHEREAS, The Clinton administration did not require proper Fed-  
13 eral Food and Drug Administration review of the medical abortion pill  
14 RU-486; and

15 WHEREAS, Since that time at least seven American women have died  
16 as a result of the use of RU-486, most recently Holly Patterson, 18 years  
17 of age, of Livermore, California, on September 17, 2003; and

18 WHEREAS, There is currently a bill before the Congress of the  
19 United States, H.R. 3453, 108th Cong., 1st Sess. (2003), seeking to sus-  
20 pend the use of RU-486 until the Comptroller General of the United  
21 States reviews the process by which the Food and Drug Administration  
22 approved the use of such drug; Now, therefore,

23 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kan-*  
24 *sas:* That the Kansas Legislature urges the Congress of the United  
25 States to pass H.R. 3453, 108th Cong., 1st Sess. (2003), known as the  
26 RU-486 suspension and review act of 2003; and

27 *Be it further resolved:* That the Secretary of State is hereby directed  
28 to provide an enrolled copy of this resolution to the President pro tem-  
29 pore of the United State Senate, to the Speaker of the United States  
30 House of Representatives and to each member of the Kansas Congres-  
31 sional Delegation.
