AN ACT concerning schools and school districts; relating to certain pupils participating in interscholastic activities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Any pupil who is home-schooled shall be eligible to participate in interscholastic activities of the school district in which such home school is located if the pupil is:

(1) A bonafide undergraduate member of the home school and is in good standing;

(2) enrolled in and attending a minimum of five subjects, not previously passed, of unit weight or its equivalency during the present semester; and

(3) meets all other eligibility requirements of the Kansas state high school activities association other than enrollment at a public or accredited nonpublic school in the district.

(b) As used in this section, "activities" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in K.S.A. 72-133, and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
