9 AN ACT relating to natural gas public utilities; concerning transportation
10 customers; requirements.

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12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) A natural gas public utility, as defined in K.S.A. 66-
14 1,200, and amendments thereto, and a natural gas marketer, providing
15 service to a transportation customer shall:

16 (1) When determining the cashout adjustment calculation for any
17 nomination imbalances for a given month for such transportation cus-
18 tomer, use a monthly average to determine such cashout rate for the
19 month in which the imbalance occurred; and

20 (2) provide written notice by mail, e-mail or fax at least 30 days in
21 advance to such transportation customer when the last day of service will
22 be for the following month of service.

23 (b) A natural gas public utility shall be subject to the electric, natural
24 gas and water billing standards adopted by the state corporation com-
25 mission. A natural gas public utility which fails to comply with such billing
26 standards shall be subject to the penalties provided in K.S.A. 66-138 or
27 66-177, and amendments thereto.

28 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29 publication in the statute book.
